Parking on the school grounds is a privilege. The following conditions must be met to obtain and maintain permission to park in the student designated parking area.

- Student will register the vehicles that they intend to drive to school. <u>New applications</u> <u>and parking passes must be obtained each school year</u>. Applications may be obtained in Student Services or on the school's website.
- 2. To register:
  - The student must complete the Student Parking Application. (including parent signature)
  - Student is assigned a parking section.
  - <u>"Student Parking" pass should be visible through the windshield.</u>
  - A parking permit fee of \$5 per vehicle will be charged.
- 3. Students must adhere to the parking rules listed below and others as described in the Student Handbook. Infractions of any rules may result in a detention or termination of parking and driving privileges on campus.
  - Students are to park in their assigned parking sections only.
  - All traffic signals, signs—temporary or permanent and markings on the pavement are to be followed.
  - Speeding or reckless driving on the campus will result in loss of parking and driving privileges.
  - Car alarms that continually engage during school hours will be asked to keep alarms turned off.
  - Students are to report any damaged or stolen property to the office immediately.
  - No loitering in the school parking lot area.
  - Drivers are responsible for the actions of their passengers while driving on campus.
  - Orangeburg Prep is not responsible for any damages, thefts, or other losses incurred on any vehicle that is parked on Orangeburg Prep property at any time.
