Class of 2019 Facts & Comparisons

CLASS OF 2019: The fifty-nine graduating seniors of the Class of 2019 perpetuate Orangeburg Prep's legacy of academic excellence. Twenty-seven students were recognized by the South Carolina Independent School Association as SCISA Honor Graduates for having scored at least 1100 on the SAT or 24 on the ACT, and obtaining a 3.5 grade point average for each of seven semesters. And, forty-one students graduated with high honors which means they have a cumulative grade point average of 4.0 or higher, while twenty-three students earned Life Scholarship. Furthermore, Orangeburg Prep has five students receiving the Palmetto Fellows Award. To receive the Palmetto a student must score at least 1200 on the SAT or 27 on the ACT, earn a cumulative 3.5 GPA, and rank in the top six percent of their class. A student who is not in the top six percent of his/her class may earn the Palmetto by scoring either 1400 on the SAT or 32 on the ACT and earn a cumulative 4.0 GPA. Among colleges and universities that our graduates will attend are Anderson University, Charleston Southern University, Clemson University, College of Charleston, Georgia Southern University, Lander University Honors College, Lehigh University, Pennsylvania State University Beaver Campus, Presbyterian College, Savannah College of Art and Design, Southern Wesleyan University, The Citadel, The Citadel Honors Program, The University of Georgia, The University of South Carolina, The University of South Carolina Honors College, The University of South Carolina Beaufort, and Wofford College.
