ORANGEBURG PREPARATORY SCHOOLS, INC., is an independent, college-preparatory, coeducational day school enrolling students in preschool through twelfth grade. Orangeburg Prep is accredited by AdvancED and the South Carolina Independent School Association (SCISA). The school's other affiliations include the Southern Association in Independent Schools (SAIS), the National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP), and the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD).

ACADEMIC PROFILES: 4.4% of our eighth graders qualified for the highest award given by the South Carolina Independent School Association – The George Grice Award; 5 % of our seventh graders qualified for the Duke Talent Identification Program (Duke TIP). This requires a student to score in the 95th percentile or higher; Orangeburg Prep's seventh graders earned more than the national average in qualifying for the Duke Talent Identification Program.

AP (ADVANCED PLACEMENT) COURSES OFFERED: AP Biology, AP Calculus, AP Human Geography, AP U.S. History

DUAL CREDIT: English 101, English 102, Psychology, and Public Speaking 140 are offered through USC-Salkehatchie. Students may receive up to twelve college credit hours.

2016 ACT/Aspire: OPS scored above the national percentage in grades third through eighth in English at an average of 83%.

ORANGEBURG PREP HIGHLIGHTS: 665 students in Pre K—12th grades, approximately 100 faculty and staff, Child Development Center, Student Center (peer tutoring program), forty-two athletic teams, two campuses, two gyms, two libraries, award-winning Fine Arts Department, academic clubs, civic clubs, special interests clubs, and speech / resource services.

Class of 2016 Facts & Comparisons

CLASS OF 2016: The thirty-seven graduating seniors of the Class of 2016 perpetuate Orangeburg Prep's legacy of academic excellence. Six students were recognized by the South Carolina Independent School Association as SCISA Honor Graduates for having scored at least 1100 on the SAT and obtaining a 3.5 grade point average for each of seven semesters. And, twenty-two students graduated with high honors which mean they have a cumulative grade point average of 4.0 or higher, while eight students earned Life Scholarship. Furthermore, Orangeburg Prep has one student receiving the Palmetto Fellows Award. To receive the Palmetto a student must score at least 1200 on the SAT or 27 on the ACT, earn a cumulative 3.5 GPA, and rank in the top six percent of their class. A student who is not in the top six percent of his/her class may earn the Palmetto by scoring either 1400 on the SAT or 32 on the ACT and earn a cumulative 4.0 GPA. Among colleges and universities that our graduates attended were Air Force, Charleston Southern, Clemson University, Coastal Carolina, Columbia College, Erskine College, National Guard, Midlands Technical College, Newberry O-C Technical College, Purdue University, Tri County Technical College, USC Honors College, USC-Aiken, University of South Carolina, USC-Aiken, U.S.C. Sumter, and Wofford.
