Answer the following questions for the book. Your responses should be written neatly in pen or typed in **complete sentences. (Points will be deducted for incomplete sentences and spelling/grammar errors!)**

1. Write the names of the most important characters in the story. Describe them and identify their relationships to one another.
2. Where does most of the action take place?
3. What part of the story was the funniest? Most exciting? Saddest?
4. Judge the main character's actions in the story and describe how you might have acted differently.
5. Think about the story. Write three new titles for the story that would give others a good idea about the story.
6. What was the author's purpose in writing the book? What idea, feeling did he want to give you about the story?
7. Describe the most important event in this book and tell why you think it is important. Make sure you completely describe the event.
8. How does this book connect to your own personal life experiences, other pieces of literature, or historical events?
9. Did you enjoy this book? Why or why not? Give specific examples from the book of things you did or did not like.
10. Describe the ending (resolution) of the book.
