Harry Hampton Fund Scholarships For Graduating Seniors:

- 1. Harry Hampton Scholarship for students in the natural resources disciplines of wildlife biology, fisheries biology, forestry, marine or environmental science.

 Four (4) years; \$5,000 per year.
- 2. Wallace F. Pate Scholarship for students in the natural resources disciplines of wildlife biology, fisheries biology, forestry, marine or environmental science.

 One (1) year; \$2,500.

Natural resource students may apply for the Hampton and Pate scholarships together on one application, but are eligible to be awarded only one. <u>Agriculture, general biology, premedical biology and veterinary science are NOT eligible curricula for these scholarships.</u>

- 3. David M. Cline Scholarship for students who wish to further their education in law enforcement / criminal justice / forensic science. Pre-medical curricula on a path to forensic medicine does NOT qualify for this scholarship.

 One (1) year; \$2,000.
- 4. James O. Thomason Scholarship for students who wish to further their education in print or photo journalism, advertising, public relations or mass communications. This scholarship requires the student to submit a topical essay (see criteria and application). Four (4) years; \$2,000 per year.
