Dear Seniors and Senior Parents,

Plans have been finalized and reservations secured for the Senior Class Trip to Charlottesville, Virginia, Annapolis and Baltimore, Maryland, as well as Washington, DC for the week of March 5-10, 2018. The trip has been priced at \$850.00 per student based on all 47 Seniors traveling. Should less than the entire class travel, the cost could be slightly higher. **However, the actual cost to each student will be determined by the amount of money the class earns from fund-raising projects by the time the final payment is due on February 6, 2018.** The class expects to earn additional money this year from Wrapping Paper sales, Halloween Carnival Haunted House, Senior Class Barbeque, and perhaps a few other projects to be decided by the class members. Your support in all of these activities will help defray the cost of the trip.

**The initial NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of \$200.00 is due on Tuesday, October 17, 2017.** Payment of this deposit commits your child to the trip and to the completion of payments for the trip. Please return the attached form with your deposit.
