

Writing:

- **1 ½" 3- ring binder**
 - a solid color with a clear, plastic sleeve on the front ; a heavy duty binder is best as these will wear down quickly
- **5 plastic dividers with pockets**
- **PLENTY of loose leaf paper** (Wide ruled)
- **Red, blue, and black pens (3 of each)**
- **One 2-pocket folder with HOLES** (to store in the binder)
- **PLENTY of pencils**

Reading:

- **2 marbled composition** notebooks
- **6 glue sticks** (to be kept in class)
- **Colored pencils** & a handheld sharpener
- **2-3 pads of 3x3 Post-It Notes**
- **Highlighters** (several)
- **Several** packs of **3x5 notecards** (to last throughout the school year)
